Knepp's Takes on New Life

810 Washington Street, The former Knepp Department Store, is a 30,000 square foot, four-story anchor in the heart of our downtown. After sitting vacant for several years, a small team will be transforming the space into a multiple unit commercial/hospitality and residential mixed use space.

"We've been looking for the right property for over a year to develop a mixed-use space that promotes community attachment, renewal and pride," said Jenifer Acosta, project partner in 810 Washington Bay City, LLC and owner of Acosta Real Estate & Development. "We are looking to add a sense of playfulness and fun to downtown Bay City with this project and are excited to get started."

Construction is slated to start in the fall of 2022 and conclude by Summer of 2023.
